What is Rotaract Mora Model United Nations?

Rotaract Mora Model United Nations (RMMUN) is a simulation of the United Nations, launched by Rotaract Club of University of Moratuwa as its latest project under the avenue of International Service. Since this will be the first attempt at a UN simulation by a Sri Lankan university, the project will indeed be revolutionary. The first stage of the project will mainly develop the MUN culture within the University of Moratuwa. The second stage will be open for all Sri Lankan universities.

The first-ever conference of RMMUN was held on the 3rd of January, 2021 via Zoom. It was open to all the undergraduates of University of Moratuwa and the 2019 A/L batch students who were eligible to enter the University of Moratuwa.

What is Covenant?

Covenant is the first subproject launched under Rotaract Mora Model United Nations 2021. The contest is based on research and crisis management which are key components of MUN. Participants must research a specific global crisis and submit a feasible solution(s) on resolving it collaboratively.



Submissions

- Select a global crisis from the three topics that will be given over the next few weeks.
 Conduct in-depth research regarding the crisis on,
 - 1. The impacts of it
 - 2. Reason and origin of the crisis
 - 3. Future repercussions and consequences if it lasts for a long time
 - 4. The countries/communities that can, or have already ended or lessened the impacts of the crisis
 - 5. How can they COLLABORATIVELY resolve the crisis? (Diplomatically)
 - 6. How it impacts the local community and some solutions that you can come up with.
- Express your ideas and solutions in an attractive manner (use creative media) and present them. You may use,
 - 1. A PowerPoint presentation
 - 2. A creative speech
 - 3. A creative writing
- Submit your work using the relevant submission link along with a separate document containing the links (URLs/citations) which assisted you to formulate your solutions. (Please be mindful to not partake in the act of plagiarism)

- You may participate in the event individually or as a group (with not more than five participants).
- This will be open to all the undergraduates of the University of Moratuwa and the 2020 A/L batch students who are eligible to enter the University of Moratuwa.

- You can acquire many valued skills such as critical thinking, crisis management, presentation, researching, creativity, language, and so forth.
- We will announce three winners from each of the three topics. The winners will receive the opportunity of having their solution forwarded to the relevant avenue where they will have the honour of making a huge impact on that field. It is also our pleasure as Rotaract Mora MUN to provide you with this chance to know how it will lighten your future as well as to make an impact on the society. All the participants will receive certificates for their positions (first three places) or participation.
